When to mention your affiliation with Cambridge Public Health

Publications:

- Please list Cambridge Public Health as a centre you are affiliated with in relevant publications.
- Suggested ways to show affiliation are:
 - o In title:
 - Carol Brayne, Department of Psychiatry, Cambridge Public Health, University of Cambridge
 - Carol Brayne ^[1,2] 1. Department of Psychiatry; 2. Cambridge Public Health
 - o In acknowledgement section:
 - "CB acknowledges support from Cambridge Public Health." Where such support is relevant, e.g. in facilitating collaborations, pillar and cross cutting theme could be mentioned here.
